

# California Designated Operator Program

## Facility Employee Training

## Leak Detection Systems

Our training will include a complete overview of the leak detection systems theory of operation, purpose and employee responsibilities relating to the operation of the system.

## Spills and Overfills

The entire response process of spills and overfills will be reviewed.

- Monitoring Plan
- Plot Plans
- Form A and Form B operating permits
